We have recently received information from The Department of Veteran Affairs that there is a new system available for those Veterans who experience tinnitus that is not helped by hearing aids—using Neuromonics, which was developed here in WA, and is used by the American Veterans. If you have tinnitus that is affecting your ability to concentrate or sleep please come and see us for further help.

IPHONE READY?

The latest gadget in hearing aid accessories is the addition of an iPhone app. For those with wireless bluetooth devices that connect to the TV and mobile phone this removes the need for an interface device or neckloop worn remotely. These new apps mean that you can use your phone as the interface. An iPhone can be used as a remote control or linked directly to your hearing aids for hands free use. It can also connect with iPads for Skype phone calls or facetime movies or music - the choice is yours! Starkey and Oticon have been the first to come out with this option but with all things in the hearing industry, if its popular everyone gets on board too. Call us for more information.

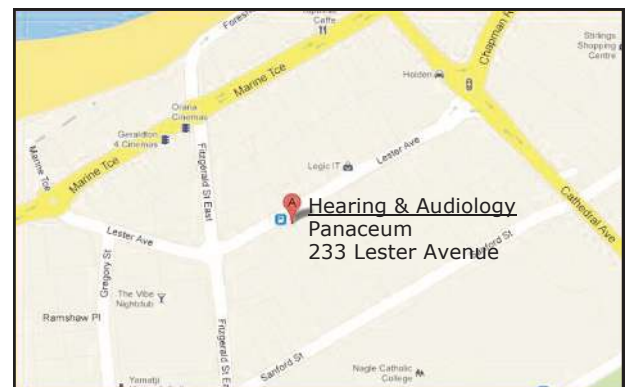

WAX GUARDS & BATTERIES

Cerustops are a common type of wax system that can be upgraded to c guard which has an easier twist removal system. The packaging is different, see below not to be confused with Starkey's red stick system.

If your battery does not work when inserted into the hearing aid please wait for two minutes and try again. Manufacturers are recommending two minutes after peeling off the sticker before use.
